



#### **Happy September!**

There are many happenings in our community this month so make sure to include at least some of these fabulous events in your schedule!

If you like to hula hoop, limbo, enjoy music and like to hang out with your neighbors, come join in the fun for the **Annual Labor Day Lagoon Party** on Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup>. Gate opens at 10:00am and party runs from 11:00am to 4:00pm. (The lagoon pool will be open on weekends through the end of September.)

If boating is more your speed, the Lakes Committee is hosting our first ever "Patriot Day Boat Parade" on Sunday, September 10th. This event is to honor the largest sea evacuation in history, which occurred on 9/11. Larger than the evacuation of Dunkirk in WWII (339,000 soldiers were rescued over 9 days). The Desert Shores Patriot Day Boat Parade will take place on Lake Jacqueline, is scheduled to 1:30pm, and begin with categories of boats, electric boats and human powered boats (think kayaks and pedal), decorated to show their patriotic spirit. If you don't own a boat and would like to participate, Desert Shores has a few pedal boats and available (must reserve in kayaks advance). provide Yου decorations! If you just want to watch the festivities, the swim lagoon will be open, come swim, watch the parade and cheer on your neighbors! The lake ends are also a good location to watch the parade. The electric boats will cruise the full length of Lake Jacqueline and the human powered boats will stay south of the bridge. Please contact the DSCA office with your questions.

Our Annual Desert Shores Night Out gives our residents an opportunity to meet, talk with and thank our local First Responders. We will have hotdogs, drinks (while supplies last), music, swimming (last chance to swim for the season!), and Raffle Prizes!

In order to have your application on the agenda, you must submit all completed paperwork to the DSCA office along with the \$10 application fee by the Wednesday prior to the CRC meeting by 3:00pm.

NOTE: If you reside in Harbor Cove, Spinnaker Cove, Diamond Bay, La Jolla Classic, Ritz Cove, Desert Shores Racquet Club or Pelican Point, you are required to obtain approval from your Sub-Association <a href="PRIOR">PRIOR</a> to submitting your application to Desert Shores. Please keep this in mind when planning your changes to your home. The approval letter is part of the application checklist.

It is always good news when you or your neighbors are fixing up the exterior of their homes. When we take good care of our property, it helps the whole community! Modifications to a property's exterior (front or back) require the submittal of an ARC Application for review & approval.

For more information or guidance, please contact the Community Relations Coordinator, **Terry Brobeck**, via email **crc@mydesertshores.com** or by phone at **(702) 254-0628**.

At their July 26, 2023, meeting, the Board voted to begin enforcement of the CC&Rs Article IX, Section 9.07 and Bylaws Article XII "Notice and Hearing Procedure". All exterior improvements or changes require ARC approval prior to start of project. Beginning October 1, 2023, owners will be called to a hearing and fines can be imposed for owners making changes prior to receiving the required approval.

#### **Deadline for Declaring Candidacy for the Board**

If you are interested in committing yourself to your community and would like to have a part in the future of Desert Shores, then declare your candidacy by completing the 2023 Candidacy Form, enclosed in this newsletter.

Your completed candidacy form must be received at the DSCA office located at 2500 Regatta Drive no later than 5:00 pm, Monday, October 2, 2023.

Each person whose name is placed on the ballot as a candidate for a member of the executive board must: (a) Make a good faith effort to disclose any financial, business, professional or personal relationship or interest that would result, or would appear to a reasonable person to result, in a potential conflict of interest for the candidate if the candidate were to be elected to serve as a member of the executive board; and (b) the candidate must be in "good standing" with the association. (NRS 116.31034.9(b))

The Desert Shores Annual Meeting and Election will be held Wednesday, November 15, 2023, at 5:30 pm at the DSCA Clubhouse. Members will cast their votes for three (3) two-year positions on the Board of Directors. The terms of Sharon Rennie, Donna Toussaint, and Mike Christian are expiring. Candidate statements will be mailed to homeowners, along with ballots, that will be tallied at the Annual Meeting.

Homeowners will have an opportunity to meet the candidates at a "Meet the Candidates Night" scheduled for Wednesday, October 18, 2022, at 6:30 pm in the DSCA Clubhouse.

# Thinking of Running for the Board? Do you Have What it Takes?

If the idea of running for a board position has crossed your mind, take a moment to reflect on the following three questions:



#### Do I have the time?

Serving as a board member requires a significant time commitment. You should be prepared to dedicate several hours each to association related matters. Beyond attending regular monthly board meetings, your involvement will extend to active participation in email discussions and occasional special meetings. During special projects, there may be additional time demands on your end.



#### Can I make tough decisions, when necessary?

The primary responsibility of the board involves overseeing the association's operations. This involves more than just budget approval; it encompasses the development and enforcement of policies as well. As a board member, you'll need to step beyond your immediate circle of neighbors and make decisions that serve the greater good of the community.



#### Can I do all this and have fun too?

Board involvement isn't solely about policies and tough choices. The strength of our community depends on the efforts we put into it. Part of being a board member involves creating and nurturing a sense of community. Your presence in the community matters as much as any policy decisions you contribute to.

While there might be moments of frustration, being a board member can also be one of the most rewarding ways to volunteer your time.

# Duties & Responsibilities

- Patrol Lagoon and Clubhouse Area
- Secure Facilities at night and open in the mornings
- Check parties in and out of the clubhouse during Private Events
- Patrol Lakes and other common areas within Desert Shores
- Check fishermen for DSCA ID's and ensures no one is fishing after dark
- Address any issues regarding our common areas
- Observe and report any issues they may find.

#### WHAT DOES OUR PATROL DO?

The Association is charged with the responsibility of managing and protecting the common areas of the Association. The Master Declaration and other governing documents do not authorize the Association to provide security and protection for individual homeowners or their property.

You may see the flashing yellow lights on the truck as the Patrol drives through the community. This is to show a presence as they are not a security force or a private patrol for individual homes. The Patrol officers are instructed to call Metro if they encounter problems of a criminal nature.

Each Patrol shift files a detailed written report that consists of property status, results of encounters, property damage and any significant incidents that may have occurred during their shift. The written reports are reviewed by the DSCA General Manger and Office Staff on a daily basis and are vital for providing key information and documenting events that occur on our property.

If you have an emergency that is a threat to bodily harm or witness a crime in progress, **call 911.** If you need police assistance or to report a crime that has already taken place, call the Metro non-emergency number 311.

To reach Patrol, dial 702-254-1020, Press 0, at any time, to be connected to the After Hours Answering Service and ask to be connected to Patrol.

Call Patrol when...
but not limited to!

Someone is feeding the waterfowl or otherwise endangering wildlife on our shores.

Boat or water vessel is on the water without a sticker or is not an approved water vessel

Someone is fishing in the lakes in violation of fishing policies or without an ID card.

Door to door sales/ soliciting is taking place. Make sure you get a description.





- 1. The Association received NRED mediation requests from Dale Appel and from Michael Leonetti on Thursday, July 20, 2023. Appel and Leonetti previously filed a lawsuit against the association regarding conduct of a prior tenant of a property owner. The lawsuit: Clark County District Court, Case No. A-22-855712-C: has been dismissed with prejudice. NRED mediation has not been scheduled at this time.
- **2.** Clark County District Court, Case N. A-22-857891-C: DSCA is pleased to announce the turf conversion lawsuit has been resolved. Pursuant to NRS 116.31088, the matter was resolved with the following terms: Plaintiffs agreed to dismiss their claims with prejudice and close the case, no money was paid to Plaintiffs, and each side agreed to pay their own attorney's fees and costs. In consultation with legal counsel the Board believed this to be the best resolution to avoid future litigation costs.

The mediations claims have been tendered to the Association insurance carrier. There are no known judgements against the Association.






