

Lake Management: Why we don't feed Wildlife

The foods humans provide to wildlife are not the foods they are adapted to eat. Corn, bread and other grain-based foods are high in carbohydrates, which few natural foods are. Wildlife that eat these foods may become unhealthy as a result of taking in too many carbohydrates in a short time, or it may interfere with their ability to process the rest of their more natural diet. The feeds provided by humans to wildlife also generally amount to junk food, and can cause excessive weight gain.

This is particularly true of waterfowl in areas where bread feeding is popular. In addition to the direct effect on their health, this weight gain can inhibit migration, and affect their long-term fitness.

Access to feeding sites also alters animal behavior.
Animals that are typically dispersed over a wide area in order to find food will instead congregate near the food source.

This increased population density makes disease transmission more likely. It also goes against the natural territoriality present in many species, and the inevitable altercations may result in injuries or even death. Higher densities of animals also equates to higher densities of those animals' parasites.

Lagoon & Playground

Lagoon Restrooms will begin February 4th and will take approx. 30 days to complete. LOCAL HOUSING MARKET UPDATE

The Greater Las Vegas Association of REALTORS® (GLVAR) recently reported that Southern Nevada home prices are leveling off, with more homes on the market and fewer properties changing hands.

GLVAR reported the median price of existing single-family homes sold during November 2018 through its Multiple Listing Service (MLS) was \$295,000, just short of October's median price of \$295,025, but still up 13% from \$261,150 in November 2017. Meanwhile, the median price of local condominiums and townhomes sold in November 2018 was \$164,000. That's down 5.2% from October 2018, but up 16.5% from the same time last year.

Local home prices have generally been rising since 2012, although they have not reached their all-time peak of \$315,000 in June of 2006. Local home prices hit a post-recession bottom of \$118,00 in January of 2012.



Landscape Talk

February Landscape Tips

Early spring is primetime for putting down soil sulfur around your plants, particularly those that prefer a more acidic soil. If you aren't sure whether or not your trees and shrubs are acid-loving, you can still apply soil sulfur without doing damage to your landscape. Las Vegas soil is notoriously alkaline, so a little sulfur will only serve to neutralize it a bit and make it easier for your plants to draw up other nutrients.


About three to four weeks after pruning roses, it's time to wake them up with fertilizer. You'll want to use epsom salts, cottonseed meal and superphospates in order to provide them with everything they need to put on a good show throughout the season. It's also time to feed your fruit trees with the same components that you would use on roses, but with a high-nitrogen fertilizer added in as well.


plant them indoors in February so that they'll be ready to move outside in mid-to-late-March.

If you want to get a spring vegetable garden started from seeds,

Use a seedling mix and start them in a sunny window or under grow lights in 4" pots. Keeping a spray bottle nearby makes it much easier to water the soil without washing out the seeds.
